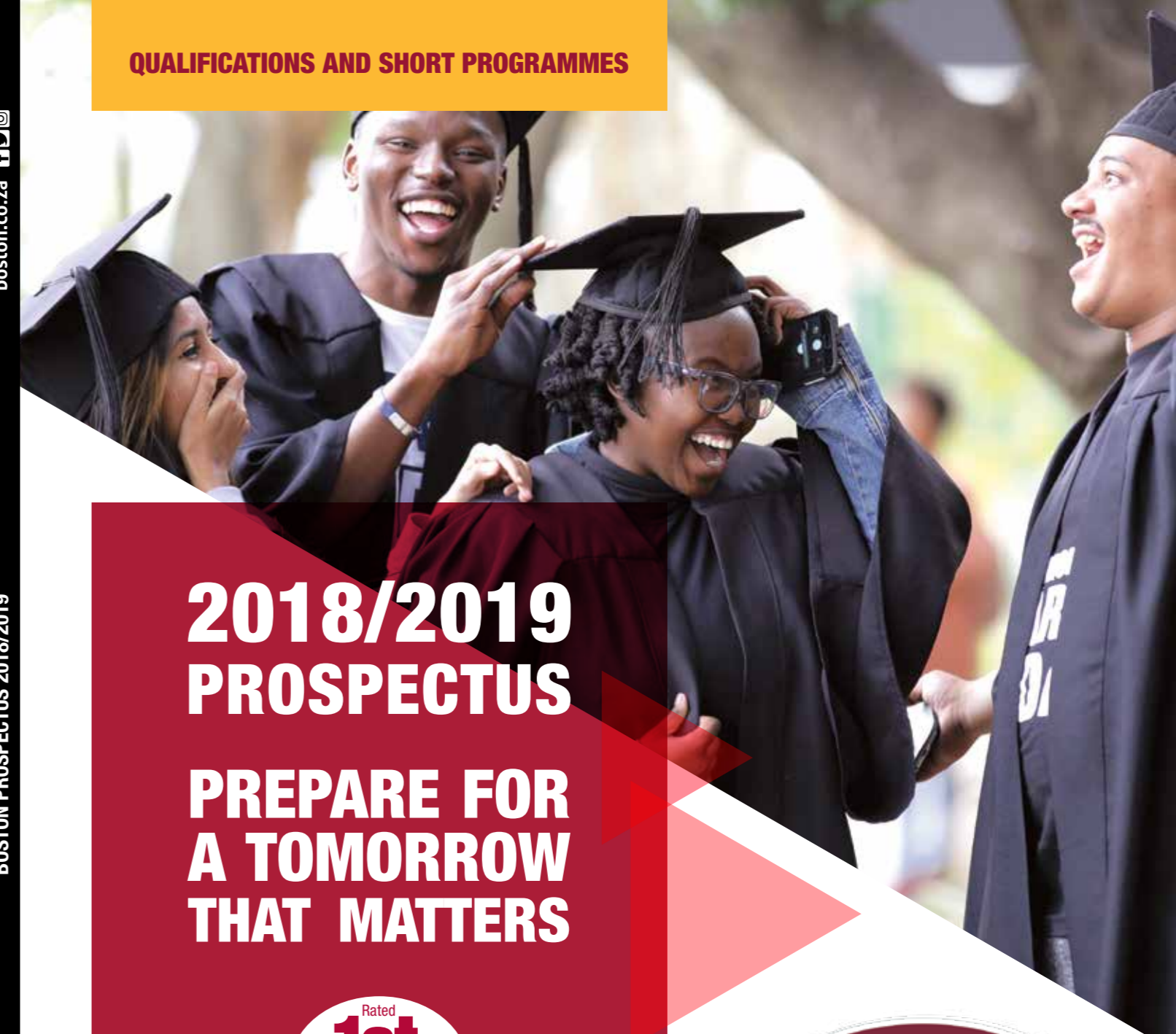

## ▶ WHAT IS ACCREDITATION?
